



## INCUMBENT WORKER TRAINING (IWT) PRIORITIES FOR 2011-2012

Each application for funding is evaluated for the following priorities and awarded one point for each:

- Science, Technology, Engineering & Math (STEM) &/or Manufacturing company
- Requesting a STEM training
- Training requested is for the company's lower skilled/lower wage workers
- Trainees will receive a pay raise at the successful completion of training
- Small employers with fewer than 100 employees
- A company that has not received EWIB or DOL Incumbent Worker Training previously

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Company may request no more than \$10,000 or \$3,000 per worker trained
- A 50% cash match is required of companies with more than 100 CT employees. Companies with fewer than 100 employees may match with wages paid during training.
